- She further mentioned about Seed –The future Entrepreneurs competition which was organized by La Fondation Dassault Systemes’ in association with Atal Innovation Mission NITI Aayog , Govt of India, where students from 29 states in the country participated in the entrepreneurship challenge. City Pride School team ITACS won this competition and bagged prize money of Rs.75000. They created an innovative product “MISTI " Modern Indoor System for trapping Insects. It is used for catching insects effectively after working on the product design for past 9 months.

Talking further Ma'am mentioned about the Best School Award where City Pride Group of Schools finds itself on the pedestal of the prestigious "Times School Survey" of best school in two categories, that is – The Innovative Learning School and Students Satisfaction.

Further Ma'am mentioned about the achievements of our computer teachers Ms. Amruta Dike and Ms. Aafreen Usmani , who presented their research paper titled "An innovative approach to teach Computational Thinking to Specially abled children", at the 4th conference on Computational Thinking in school organised by CS Pathshala (CTiS) an ACM India initiative held in IISER Pune.

Further Ma'am commended the students for their various achievements in sports.

1. Kimaya Chorbele of class X Faith has received Bronze Medal at National Yoga Olympiad held by NCERT in Delhi from 18th – 20th June 2022. In Jaipur Premium League 2022 held by Yoga Federation of India from 23rd July to 24th July 2022, received 5 Gold Medals.
2. Shreya Vibhandik of class VIII Hope- In Jaipur Premium League 2022 held by Yoga Federation of India from 23rd July to 24th July 2022, received 3 Gold & 2 Silver medals.
3. Riya Pawar IX Hope Stood 9th at State level in rifle shooting championship and also got selected for Pre-nationals.

She also mentioned about the various activities and celebrations like -

1. Ashadi Ekadashi- Vitthal idol was made from the waste pipes, old musical instruments, broom plastic face boxes by the Art, Craft and Fashion Design Department teachers and students.
2. Umbrella Painting workshop was organised for students on 2nd July 2022 by the art teachers.
3. Kalamanch where, **Dr. Saleel Kulkarni**, a renowned Marathi music composer, singer and author inaugurated the platform on 1st July 2022. This platform will enable our school students and teachers from all the three branches to showcase their talent and skills.
4. Ma'am mentioned about the Investiture ceremony.

5. International connect- Collaboration with a school from Taiwan- Students of Std 7 and 8 had an interactive collaboration in the month of March where they shared the food culture of both the countries.

Students of Std 7 had a collaborative story reading session in the month of June 2022 under the Sustainable Development Goal No. 6 Clean Water and Sanitation.

Ma'am spoke about the general rules and regulations to be followed during regular school and spoke about the upcoming events in Term – 1.

3) Announcement of E- PTA Members

Ma'am, mentioned about the formation of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee consists of -

4) Scheme of Assessment for Std 10 & 12

Ma'am briefed about the Scheme of Assessment for Board Examination Class X for the session 2022- 23.

She said that last year due to pandemic situation the Board Exams were Term wise but this year there will be three exams conducted throughout the year and the final exam will take into consideration 100% syllabus, so students have to be regular in their studies. This will enable them to do better in the final exams.

5) Any other point with the permission of chairperson

Following suggestions and doubts were noted and answered by the Chairperson, Ms. Maya Sawant:

- a) Parent of 3rd Love mentioned that there are many queries in WhatsApp group whether HW should be written in the school diary as it's mentioned in Teams. Maya Madam explained the purpose of mentioning in the Teams. However, it should be encouraged that students write in the diary as well for the sake of writing practice which was lost in the online mode. But parents must check in the Teams as well.
- b) The parent further pointed out that messages from school come late in the evening, such as bringing art material and so on etc. Ma'am assured that we would inform the teachers to inform students in advance.
- c) Time table must mention which book of language should be brought that day, for example, literature / grammar.

d) Parents must get the freedom to buy school shoes from any vendor close to their residence . Principal Madam mentioned that parents are free to buy the shoes from any vendor. School has no particular vendor . Same is the case with school uniforms. Parents are free to buy uniform from any vendor.

e) Parent of Sai Bhise, 1st Wisdom, said that there is rumour that board exmas will be held for std 3, 8 and 11 and no such exams for Std X or XII. This is creating confusion among students and wanted to know if City Pride School will follow the same. Maya Madam assured that there is no such circular so do not worry.

f) Parent of 9th Faith , Mr Yogesh Bhosale, wanted to understand more about the assessment pattern hence the slide on the same was shared again and Maya Madam explained the process in which internal marks are counted and how final marks get added. Mam also emphasised that parents must be with students to understand if their children are facing any problems. We have remediation classes for students who find Mathematics difficult.

g) Parents wanted to know about the initiative that City Pride Sschool has undertaken, namely, Kalamanch and wanted to know if all can participate in it. Mam cleared that this time renowned singer Dr. Salil Kulkarni was invited hence students who have singing as their elective subject were invited for this programme. Next one would be related to dancing and would be conducted at Moshi branch.

h) Maya Madam requested to that all parents must read the notices carefully before they put up any enquiry on any group. Mrs. Nisha Panicker, supervisor added that Std 9th & 10th need to be registered to CBSE portal for which they must come at the given time to check the data of their own child.

i) Parent of Vanshika Phadnare, enquired if the breakfast committee members inspect food every day. Parent of, Anvik Panchal enquired about the quality of food. Maya Madam explained that a breakfast committee of parents group is formed and they can come anytime to inspect the breakgast. The Management has spoken with the vendor and a months' time has been given to him to improve quality and quantity of the same

j) Parent of Std 5th congratulated all the staff of City Pride School for their efforts in online as well as offline mode. However, he wished that school decreases the timing of school by an hour as students get exhausted and students also have other classes. Maya Madam voiced that this is not possible because we have areas like Visual and performing arts , Softskill etc along with main subject periods in the time table. Moreover we have school only for 5 days. i.e. Monday to Friday , so students get ample time on Saturday and Sunday.

k) Parent of Std 4th Love wanted to know what can be done about bag weight. Maya Madam assured that we have Bag weight Management system where random 5 bags of a class are checked every day. Many students carry unwanted books as well hence the bags becomes heavy. Parents also can check their wards bags randomly in between.

- l) Parent of 2nd Joy, asked if school will use hybrid mode due to the increase in number of viral infection cases. Maya madam explained we take proper care at school. Window nets are fixed , tais fumigate the classes regularly with dhoop Parents should not send children with any kind of viral infections.
- m) Parent of 2nd, Mr. Vivek Sule, voiced that 2nd and 4th Saturdays should be used for all interactions as parents work does not allow them any other holiday. He also asked if bus service can be provided for evening sports. Madam answered that most of the times we have open / interaction day on 2nd and 4th Saturdays but sometimes it may not be possible. There is no bus service in the evening for students who wait for sports.
- n) Parent of Ashish Haravade , asked if Parents can contribute in any way if they have expertise in some area, Maya madam assured that this is possible.
- o) Parent Mr. Vijay Bhanushali thanked all the school staff for doing a good job. He appreciated the work done by City Pride School family.
