B Distribution of PTA Fund :-

C] Fee structure for the year 2024-2025: -

Chairperson, Mrs Maya Sawant, further stated that the fee structure for the academic year 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 was fixed during the E-PTA meeting conducted on 01.10.2022. All the members had raised their hands and had unanimously agreed to the proposed fee structure for the academic year 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.

Point no.4] Admission process for the academic year 2024-2025: -

Chairperson Mrs Maya Sawant explained the details about the aadmission process for the academic year 2023-2024. The admission notice will be published on the school website www.cityprideschool.com, on the school notice board and in the newspaper as well.

- Admission process for LKG for the academic year 2024-2025 will start in first week of December. Being a Konkani linguistic school, preference for LKG admissions will be given to Konkani Linguistic students. Preference will be given to siblings and teacher's ward as well.
- Admission process for UKG to Higher standards for the academic year 2024-2025 will start after 16th Jan 2024, in case of vacancy only. Baseline test will be conducted as per the vacancy status. Admissions will be given on merit basis only.

Point no.5] Staff recruitment for the academic year 2024-2025:-

Staff recruitment for the academic year 2024-2025 will be done as per the need analysis of the school for teaching and non-teaching staff. Advertisement will be given in local newspaper (Times of India and Maharashtra Times) for the same and the same will be displayed on the school website as well. Interview, written exam and demo will be conducted accordingly for the shortlisted candidates.

Point no 6] Replacement of teacher member of E-PTA for Std 11th - 2023-2024.

Chairperson Mrs Maya Sawant informed other E-PTA members that E-PTA teacher member of Std 11th Ms Anuradha Kumari has resigned due to her personal reason. Hence we followed the selection process for the same and Ms Manjusha Kunkolienkar is a new E-PTA teacher member of Std 11th – 2023-2024.

Point no.7] Any other point : -

APPAR: - AUTOMATED PERMANENT ACADEMIC ACCOUNT REGISTRY IDs-

The Chairperson, Ms Maya Sawant, discussed about the APPAR document received from the Govt

As you are aware that NEP 2020 focusses on training students to be global citizens or future leaders which will empower learners of all ages to develop the skills required to thrive as global citizens who embrace diversity in all aspects of life. In this endeavour to track the educational progress and achievement of students a unique ID will be created for each student which will help to achieve the objectives of "One Nation. One Student ID". This unique ID will be lifelong and help in accessing the educational resources too. "

APAAR ID (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry Ids) will be gateway for accessing the Digilocker ecosystems that will allow students to digitally store all achievements of students like exam results, holistic report card, learning outcomes besides other achievements of students be it OLYMPIAD, Sports, Skill training or any field. Students can use the credit score for their higher education or employment purpose in future. In this endeavour, Ministry of Education will generate APAAR ID based on Aadhaar Number of each student for which separate consent of the parents is required. The data so collected will be kept confidential and Aadhaar number will be masked while sharing the data with other government users.

She shared the document and the consent form with the members and mentioned that the school will be sending these documents to all the students of all the classes. She further requested the members to guide parents to fill in the consent form and submit the consent form copy back to school on or before 20th October 2023. She further added, we will be sending a google link too to get quick response. But submitting the hard copy is essential.

She also mentioned the use and importance of APPAR ID to all the members. [Use of APAAR ID

for students, parents and schools]

APAAR ID will be unique nature and will work as One Nation, One Student ID giving identity to students across all use purpose and will be easy for transfer of students from one school to other school, state etc. It will empower students with their own ID. This unique ID will be lifelong and help in accessing the educational resources too APAAR ID will be useful for tracking educational progress and achievement of students APAAR ID will be useful for monitoring the dropout students and mainstreaming them APAAR ID will be gateway for accessing Digilocker ecosystem which will store digitally all achievements of students like exam results, holistic report card, health card, learning outcomes besides other achievements of students be it OLYMPIAD, Sports, Skill training or any field.

Students can use the credit score for their higher education or employment purpose in future.

APAAR ID will also be used for multiple use cases e.g., Entrance tests conducted by NTA, admissions, Scholarship disbursement, transfer of government benefit, issue of awards, recognition etc. for students, teachers and other users.

Or. Arpita Gandhi parent member shared her expertise on the HPV Vaccine Drive the school has proposed along with her and other Doctor parents. She commented that the Drive must take place in November or December so that the second dose is done before the closure of the Academic session. This decision will be taken by the school very soon.

- Or. Arpita Gandhi parent member raised another concern regarding the Uniform of LKG, where she mentioned that the current quality of the cloth is bad and hence a few parents were reluctant to buy new pair from the same vendor. She was assured by our Director that the new uniform will be made from different cloth which is of a better quality hence a new pair of uniform can be safely bought from the vendor.
- Mr. Vijay Jangamashetty parent member works with Google Pune and the organization received an award from Mr. Devendra Fadnavis recently. He shared, how their company works with the NGO's and create resources for Blind students such as audio books, visual stories for students, resume making sessions, tree plantation drives etc. CPS students can be part of such resource building initiatives was one thought shared and this can be explored.
- o Ms. Deepali Gaonkar Parent member wanted to bring forward the importance of Financial literacy for our students. She was then briefed by the Vice Principal that Skill module on financial Literacy has already been done for Std. VIII and is planned for Std. VII in the month of November. This module is a session for 4 days, 3 hours each day which leads to 12 hrs. of Financial Literacy session by experts from the field. She was happy to know about the same.
- Ms. Deepali Gaonkar parent member works for Toastmasters Club which works to enhance the communication skills of all age groups. She proposed to have such clubs for school going students. Maya ma'am shared with her that school promotes many initiatives like MUN, Debates, Elocution, soft skills classes which promote efficient communication skills at CPS. This proposal needs to be understood well through a separate meeting with the Principal.
- Ms. Deepali Gaonkar parent member proposed community service or environment related activities for students, for which the Vice Principal briefed the members about Green School Audit that Std 9 students are doing to see how environment friendly our school building is and they will audit the energy and water usage by the school.
- Another E-PTA parent member, Dr.Rupali Ekbote talked about Tree Plantation drive in barren lands around the school that is a long term plan where the child plants a seed and revisits every month to take care and observe the plant growth. This can go on till the child is in school. This proposal needs to be discussed to check the practicality of this proposal.
- A concern of Oily food in the breakfast has been changed after communicating with the vendor.
- The parents appreciated the school's efforts in letting the students come to school on the days of study leave. It helps the parents if both parents are working.
- o Dr.Rupali Ekbote parent representative wanted the winter jackets (new Uniform) to be available in the month of November. This will be conveyed to the vendor.
- A discussion was made regarding book distribution in the school by the vendor. The Management representative Dr. Deepali Sawai mentioned that the school never makes it compulsory to parents to buy books from any one vendor. Only on the request made by majority of parents the school provides a space to the vendor for book distribution. School has no personal interest in this activity. Parents are free to buy books from any vendor.

All the members requested the school to have the distribution done at school itself since it makes things easy and convenient for the parents. Parents would save time, and they need not go in search of books in various places.

So, all the members unanimously agreed to have the distribution of the books done at school for the academic year 2023-2024.

Point no.8] Vote of thanks: -_Joint Secretary, Mrs Archana Ashtekar gave vote of thanks to the members. She thanked all the members. She mentioned that the next meeting will be conducted after 3 months, the date will be informed well in advance.
