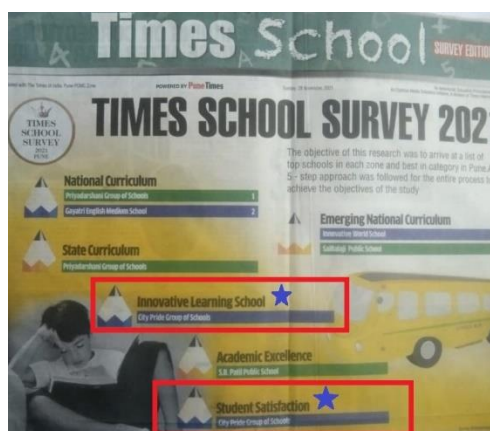


## Awards

This success would provide impetus to our efforts to take more community-based initiatives and sensitize the students towards betterment of mankind. Such projects will teach students empathy and compassion.

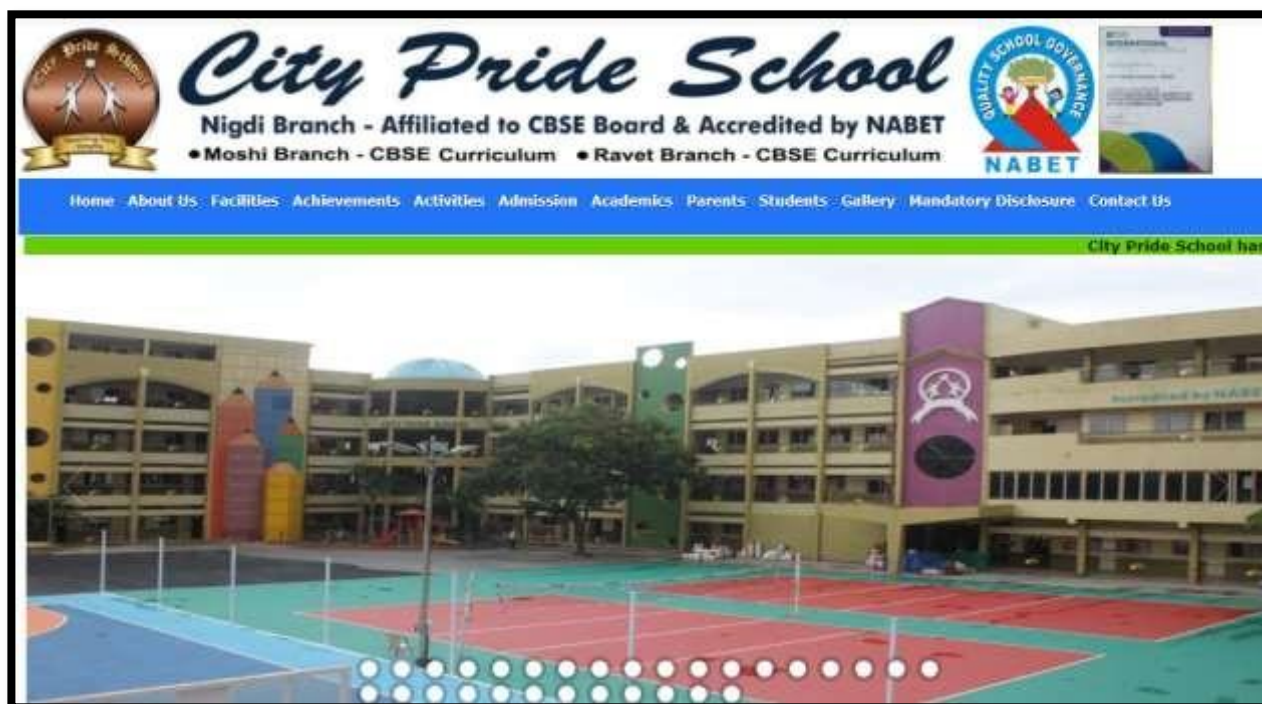

This objective is an ongoing process as due to uncertain situations like pandemics the students were to be tutored individually at their homes . So, to deliver curriculum effectively the teachers will be trained. The school believes that each child is unique and grooming them is very essential. The teachers will be trained to use the digital platform effectively

- **To train teachers to prepare a blended learning plan by integrating digital tools**

During the pandemics the online platform is the only accessible platform to deliver the curriculum. 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## School Management Committee Meet

### Important decisions taken and implemented (2021-2022)

As it was a year where Pandemic situation prevailed following decisions were taken by the management. These were implemented too.

- The school will conduct training programs for all the stakeholders to get acquainted with online platform.
- The school will adopt Microsoft Teams to deliver the curriculum effectively as well as for various interactions
- The virtual Platform to be used to conduct field visits, Co-curricular activities , webinars etc.
- There will be no fee hike due to the pandemic situation as the parents had requested for the same
- The internet connection should be updated by increasing its Bandwidth to conduct online classes was decided
- The Teachers were supported by the school by providing Laptops available in the school to conduct online classes
- No reduction in the payment of the teachers was a major decision taken by the management
- The teachers were allowed to work from home to ensure their safety during Pandemic.
- Academic programs were planned keeping in mind the virtual platform
- The management gave instructions to the principal as well as the authority to follow the protocol and the guidelines issued by the government about the reopening of the school.
- Leave Policy was redefined
- Application for the Extension of Application to be done in the month of April
- Creation of the Post of Vice Principal to distribute the work of the principal looking at the size of the school



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## Offline Education

### Re-opening of School

City Pride School has built a platform of trust and has been open for free exchange of views from all our parents in time of crucial decision making. We appreciate the suggestions and perspectives shared by our parents!

The decision to open the school was based on the directives from the Government. Students coming to school was a welcoming move considering that our students were away from school campus for past 18 months.

Almost 94 % parents were willing to send their child to school for Offline classes in January. Considering all the realities of this age group, we had decided upon the following plan (Hybrid Model).

### Offline Mode

After a break City pride school planned to start regular full day school for all the students from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022. The school started running from Monday to Friday. Saturday was a holiday. School was running in both online/offline mode simultaneously. As per the situation scenario time table was set.

For offline school students school timings were

**Std I to IV – 9:10 am to 1:45pm**

**Std.V – 8:10 am to 1:45pm**

**Std.VI to X – 8:10 am to 2:40pm**

### SAFETY NORMS –

- Parents were requested to send the child with proper mask, sanitizer bottle, napkin for personal use.
- The child had instructed to avoid sharing these items with others.
- Parents were instructed to not to send child school in case the child is sick or anyone in the family is sick.
- Thermal checking used to happen at the entry for local students and for bus students it used to happen before they board the bus.

### Online Mode

In order to cater to the students, who have opted to stay home and not attend Offline School, we had live streamed sessions as per their timings mentioned above, on all 5 **days (Monday to Friday)**.

The major focus during Offline classes was on understanding the learning gaps and working accordingly on all core subjects. This model was continued till the closure of the academic year.



### Evaluation Pattern (Diagnostic Test)

The children had been learning Online for the last 2 years. This was a universal fact and we all had embraced the new teaching learning mode with open arms.

Though we did our best and used the best of teaching strategies in Online school, we all knew that learning gaps are bound to happen.

As Educators we could foresee:

- Students had lost the habit of writing examinations.
- Fear/anxiety for exams/tests.
- They had lost the sense of time management.
- The writing speed was slow.
- Reading and Comprehension skills were affected
- Loss of habit of memorization
- Structured writing / Drawing skills were affected
- Computation skills /quick calculation habit was lost

Though these learning gaps were different for each grade, it needed to be diagnosed. Hence, the Final Examination was Diagnostic in nature. Diagnostic Test was conducted to test the basic concepts required for the next level and was not based on information/facts. It was an assessment based on which we were able to identify learning gaps (grade wise). In order to get the true picture, we requested parents to send students to school for examination.

Once the gaps get identified, we could create a Plan of Action for the month of April when new academic year begins.

We were also aware that a few parents would not be apprehensive to send their wards to school due to Corona situation. We also explained them to take stock of the situation in March and to send their child for an Offline Examination for two hours. Another possibility was that the child insisted on doing Online Exam due to anxiety /fear of exams, in such a case parents were requested to talk to their children and instil confidence and give unconditional support to overcome this fear.

For those parents who still feel their child will not come for Offline Examination, we had the provision for Online Exams for them.

This is how City Pride School planned a customised approach for its students in the upcoming year, so that NO child is left behind. We successfully conducted the diagnostic test at school level.

This Final Examination was treated as an **“ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNING – the Learning Gaps”**, which can be addressed in the upcoming session.

City Pride School, always has a thoughtful approach in all its actions and decisions.

An outside agency also conducted ASSET Diagnostic Test in the month of April for Std 3 to 10.

The test was conducted for English, Mathematics and Science subjects.

A detailed child specific analysis report will be shared with the parents in the month of June.



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## Infrastructure Details

- **Smart class rooms with Wi-Fi campus** - City Pride School has state of art classrooms equipped with LCD projectors and Computers in each class. The entire school is Wi-fi connected with internet connectivity available even in the classrooms. Teachers regularly use Computers for teaching learning and evaluation process. The school has implemented ERP system for effective learning management system

The school has installed CCTV camera on all the school gates and also GPS system in school bus for security.

- **Computer Labs**- To keep pace with advanced technology and to use computers as an application tool, two computer labs are available with internet connectivity.

- **Atal Tinkering Lab** - Atal tinkering laboratory is a work space where young minds can give shape to their ideas through hands on activities, and learn innovation skills. We at school have already introduced experiential learning program which revolves round STEAM - skills of ScienceTechnology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics. These skills develop problem solving and critical analysis and prepare students to think out of box so that students can apply knowledge to solve real life problems. ATL would contain educational and learning 'do it yourself' kits and equipment on – science, electronics, robotics, open-source microcontroller boards, sensors and 3D printers and computers. Under ATL we have conducted various activities & workshops since the commencement of these labs in our school. Under this area we have many learning spaces.

**1. Robotics Lab** - The school has established state of art Robotics lab in association with Think Labs from IIT Mumbai. The lab consists of 12 robokits and visual programming facility.

**2. Animation and Gaming lab** - A separate well equipped animation lab has been developed by school with high end hardware , software and other accessories .An experience trainer from animation industry has been appointed to impart practical knowledge to students for creating animated films and games. Students have created amazing films which are displayed at annual exhibition.

**3. Fashion Design lab**- Not only technologist but some city Pride school children can become future fashion designer too!! The school offers yet another elective for creative children as “fashion designing” since std. 6th. The students design and stitch clothes & accessories with themes in school, and display them on ramp in annual events. Qualified fashion designers are appointed for guiding children.

**4. Advance Mechanics Lab** –School has developed mechanical engineering lab with the facility of Computer aided design. The 3D printer in the school for manufacturing the actual prototypes of designs prepared by students. Various mechanical engineering concepts are strengthened through use of mechanical tools in this lab.





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- **Maths Lab-** To explore mathematical concepts in practical manner and create visual impact of mathematical concepts, the school has well equipped maths lab where students of class I-VIII visit regularly and learn maths enthusiastically.
  - **Science Labs** - School has established three science labs which stimulates the need of students to know how things work.
  - **Discovery lab** –The school has developed an additional “Discovery lab” wherein students do hands on activity. These labs develop curiosity among students and help to teach scientific principles in the most amazing way.
  - **Library** - The school has two well stocked libraries with thousands of books on various topics, magazines, reference books, CD collections for teachers and students.
  - **Medical room**– The school has well equipped medical room for first aid treatment. A doctor and a nurse is available in the school for treating medical emergency. Regular medical checkup for all students is done yearly. Medical reports are maintained by the school. Parents are informed about the same.
  - **Activity room-** An activity room well equipped with toys, Educomp smart class is available for preprimary students.
  - **Seminar Hall** – School functions and parents meetings are conducted in the school seminar hall.
  - **Counselors/Wellness teacher and Special Educators room-** to cater to learning difficulties seen among children and to help children overcome their emotional and social insecurities and achieve better confidence, school has appointed counselor, wellness teacher and a special educator also.
  - **Sports Ground-** The school has an in campus play ground to bring out the sporting talent of children and inculcate spirit of sportsmanship



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## Education at City Pride School

### Activity Based Education:

Education at City Pride School is based on project approach, experiential learning with exposure through field visits, research projects, science workshops and presentations. The education system in our school aims at helping students in understanding the facts by working hands-on, applying simpler & investigative learning way so as to arouse interest & develop better understanding in their subject. The soft skill training and the eloquent club activities aim at preparing students for 21<sup>st</sup> century skills.

### Skill Development Approach

From standard 6<sup>th</sup> onwards the school provides skill training to students to enhance the creativity, innovation, thinking, and problem-solving, communication skills, social & emotional learning along with essential life skills for building their confidence and leadership skills. The innovative programs make the children ready for 'out-of box' thinking and also helps in developing their all-round personalities.

### Robotics

Learners of all ages enjoy hands-on construction activities. Robotics is a platform for the students where they get a chance to indulge themselves with the applications of a branch of technology that deals with day to day activities. The aim of hands on experience with engineering and mechanics provided in the robotics class is to put students in the role of creating and designing with information technology.

In Robotics Lab, students learn about different mechanisms involved in different machine and the work on how to make them automatic by doing programming. Students of Std 9 learnt to control robot through mobile app using Bluetooth technology. Students of Std 10 made integrated projects using all ATL labs.

1. Connected to this CPS students **participated in various International Design Olympiads** which is organized by Design to build creative confidence through Design and Design thinking. It is a platform for young minds to embark upon a creative journey, to explore the application of knowledge gained in school and to discover their hidden talent and aptitude for design.

Also students participated in Moonshot Junior Hackathon 2021. Hackathon was organized by an MNC, Moonshot Junior in association with i4c. 35 teams were shortlisted out of 250 teams from Pune and Goa for the final round. Our students presented their idea and prototype in the final round and our Team "CPS Techy mates" having students from Grade 8 comprising Vanshika Kumar, Siddhi Desai , Ayush Patil and Harshwardhan Yewale won the first prize under problem statement-Don't flush out WaterAir. The students worked on a smart device that can reduce the wastage of water. The winning team will receive a Robotic Car kit, Moonpreneur board game, 50%scholarship on Moonshot Jr Innovator program, and Amazon Gift voucher worth Rs 11000.



### Animation and gaming

Another most popular elective that the students can choose since std. 6th is “Animation and Gaming “. A separate well equipped animation lab has been developed by school with high end hardware, software and other accessories. An experience trainer from animation industry has been appointed to impart practical knowledge to students for creating animated films and games. Students have created amazing films which are displayed at annual exhibition. Under Animation, the school students designed the images for the 8th “Doodle for Google” competition, Google invited kids to create Doodles for the given theme – “If I could teach anyone anything, it would be.....”

## Environment Awareness

### Waste Management

**1. Segregation of Waste-** During the Pandemic, students managed it at home and also spread awareness in their neighbourhood by telling the importance of segregation. Dry and wet garbage is separated, wet waste used for compost and dry waste handed over to the PCMC garbage collection vans.



#### **Visit to Waste Management Plant, Moshi**

**No. of Students: 30 students from class 6-9**

As a part of bringing awareness in students regarding segregation of waste we planned a visit to the waste management plant Moshi. Children appreciated the work done by the people there and also decided to follow segregation of waste at home and uprise people in their neighbourhood.





## **2. Best Out of Waste**

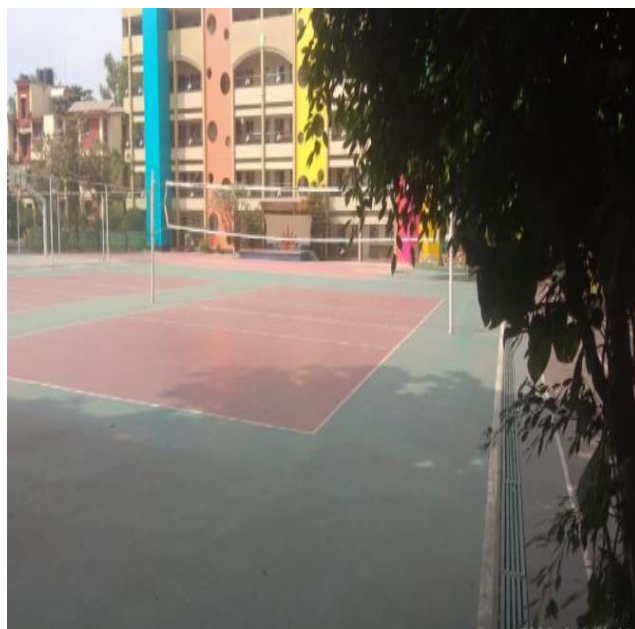
**No. of Students: 480 Students from class 7-9**

Reuse and recycling is the need of the hour. To instill this there were many activities conducted in the school. This practice is inculcated in our students so that they understand the value of things they use. We can see this paper mache mask made by class 5 children.



## **3. Cleanliness**

**Cleanliness of School-** The cleanliness of the school premises is maintained regularly by the cleanliness department.



**3. Segregation of Waste in different bins-** There is an arrangement of separate bins to collect wet and dry garbage on each floor and also separate bins in each class rooms for segregation of garbage.





#### 4. Composting

**No. of Students: 160 students of Class 7**

The students of class VII do this activity of daily dump or compost using the breakfast that is left along with the coconut choir (fibre) and microbes. All these things are mixed and moistened using water, and then are added to the compost pot on daily basis. This is done with the help of the teachers from Environment Committee. Once the compost gets ready it will be added to the plants.



**Bio Gas Plant-** The school has a Bio gas Plant managed by the students. The gas produced by it is used in the chemistry lab for various practicals.





**5. Availability of Sanitary napkins-** Sanitary napkins are made available to the girls whenever required in the medical room. Newspaper is made available for disposing sanitary napkins.

## **II. Cleanliness of Toilets**

**6. Clean and Odourfree Toilet and Separate toilets for girls and boys-** City Pride School has taken care of the basic necessity for students and teachers- the provision of clean toilets. We have washrooms for girls and boys separately on each floor so that it is easy for them. Our staff uses phenyl and other disinfectants while taking care of the cleanliness of the washrooms and instructions regarding proper use of washrooms is also explained to the students. This enables them to maintain the clean washrooms. There are washbasins and liquid soap provided so that the children can wash hands after using the washroom. Dustbins kept near the washrooms are used for throwing all waste. This maintains the cleanliness of the premise. Use of deodrants is also taken care of to keep the washroom odourfree.







## Water Conservation

### 7. Water Conservation and Rain Water Harvesting-

**No. of Students: All students in school**

City Pride School is very keen in saving water as an important natural resource. We take all steps to see that water is conserved. An innovative step taken by the school is the collection of left over water from children so that it is not thrown and wasted. Care is taken to check the taps frequently to prevent leakage.



**8. Rain water Harvesting System-** Added to this practice we also have a proper rain water harvesting system. The roof water is collected through pipelines and stored in underground tanks. This collected water is then used by the staff for gardening and cleaning purposes.





### JalDindi

### **Environmental protection awareness session**

As a part of spreading awareness among students and teachers on water conservation there was an awareness session conducted by Mr. Satish khade on “Jal hai to Kal hai” under the CPS Water Mission 2022. He enlightened us with the present state of water wastage and the ways it could be reduced so that our next generation is not deprived of clean drinking water.

### **IV. Tree Plantation and Global Warming**

**No. of Students: 20 students of class 7 & 9 and 5 of class 10**

**9. Tree Plantation** - Students and teachers have taken efforts for organic gardening in the school premises (class VII & IX). Workshop and field visit to terrace garden in Nigdi Pradhikaran was arranged for the students where they learnt about natural ways of making compost and fertilizers, natural things to be used as pesticides, etc. Also a few trees were planted by class X students and were named after the unsung heroes.



Due to the Pandemic Situation students planted few medicinal / ornamental plants at home and sent the images through Ms- Teams. They also made seed balls which were scattered when they visited forts and also gifted it to their friends and relatives.





## V. Energy Conservation

**10. Solar Panel-** City Pride School takes initiative in conserving electricity by the use of LED in almost every classroom. This reduces the energy consumption. There are electricity audits done by students which makes them understand the need for energy conservation. They analyse the usage of electricity at home and find out ways to reduce the wastage. The school has Solar Panels fitted on the terrace which helps for the supply of power whenever needed and helps in reduction of consumption of electricity supplied through MSEB

Class 7,8,9,10 made paper roll activity, Christmas decoration from waste plastic cup, pen stand



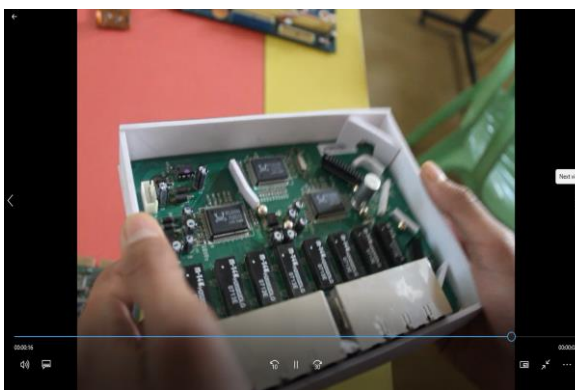
## **12. Plastic Waste Collection Drive-**

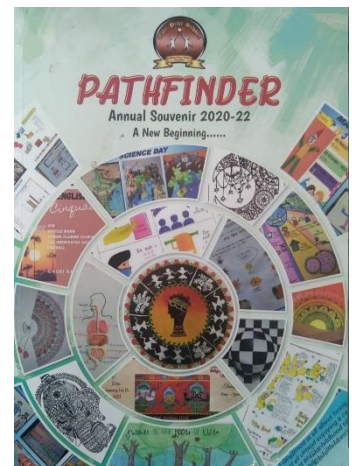


### ‘Connect to Inspire ’
