- She mentioned about STFE (Seed –The future Entrepreneurs) 2023-24 was organized by La Fondation Dassault Systemes' in association with Atal Innovation Mission NITI Aayog, Govt of India and City Pride School is a part of this program since last 4 years. The team created an innovative product "EMCT" Electronic Multipurpose Cylinder Trolley to check optimum weight of the cylinder as well as gas leakage effectively.
- She further mentioned about the school receiving "Maharashtra's Top Dynamic School 2023" award from Education Today News Network.
- She mentioned about the school being positioned in the category of Academic Excellence in a survey conducted by TOI.
- She mentioned about the school participating in 'Nrityotsava' competition organised by Kalyani School, Manjari on the 25th of June 2024 and bagged the 3rd place out of 11 schools. The theme given to all dancers was 'Indian Mythology'.

In a noteworthy achievement, the project "Sudhakhand," presented by Jiya Mittal of 6- grade and skilfully mentored by Ms. Vaishali Harugade, has secured its place among the projects heading to the Nationals.
- She mentioned about the SVAMS project (Smart Vehicle Access and Monitoring System) showcased its brilliance at the CBSE Regional Level Science Exhibition under Category-II. Presented by the talented students Aditya Singh and Amogh Hirve from City Pride School, Nigdi, and ably mentored by Ms. Kamiya Sharma.

4) Any other point with the permission of chairperson

Following suggestions and doubts were noted and answered by the Chairperson, Dr. Kanchan Deshpande:

- a) Announcement of Advisory Members: Since the E-PTA has representatives standard wise the school thought of forming a bigger group of parent members called as "Advisory Members", wherein we have two parent representatives from each division. This helps to have better communication between parents and school, thus enabling to solve concerns of every class. More parent members get a chance to share their views.
- b) New initiatives by CBSE: Ma'am informed the parents about the general features National Credit Framework and how under the National Education Policy various initiatives are taken by the Board.
- c) Chairperson Dr Kanchan Deshpande explained about NEP 2020 i.e. state of NEP are Foundational state is Nursery to Std 2nd , Preparatory stage is Std 3rd to Std 5th , Middle stage is std 6th to Std 8th and High school state is std 9th to std 12th (5 + 2 + 3 + 4)
- d) A parent – Mr. Badhe appreciated the school for the programme Carrier Fair and emphasized how it has been helpful and decisive for children of higher grades.
- e) A parent from grade 7th requested to conduct the Orientation meeting during weekends. Chairperson Dr Kanchan Deshpande said we will think on this point.
- f) Parents appreciated that the school conducts orientation meetings, monthly Interaction meetings which keeps parents updated about the plans, programmes of the school and the progress of their child.
- g) Further Chairperson Dr Kanchan Deshpande explained about the following points
 - a. Skill Subjects- Further Ma'am explained about the introduction of skill subjects for grade 6 to 8th since last academic year (2023) by CBSE where the school had successfully conducted the same – like for grade 6th – What to do when the doctor is not around, hoe to keep medicines and a certified course of first aid. For grade 7th – Design Thinking and financial literacy. For grade 8th & 9th financial literacy was conducted. The school will be conducting the same this academic year as well.
 - b. Theme of the year – Recycling is the theme of the year, the same would be for Annual day. The school in association with The Green Work Trust, (Cut the Crap) is having a plastic waste colleting drive. Every floor a box is kept where children can deposit the plastic waste. This waste would be collected at the end of every month by the organisation. Very soon an e-waste drive would also be started by the school.
 - c. Annual Day – This year school will have Annual Day for all the standards, which will be conducted in Ramkrishna More Sabhagraha in the month of November 2024.
 - d. Career Fair- As every year the school would be organizing the Career Fair – which would help the students to know and explore more options available. The fair would be conducted on 14th September 2024 in the school premises. Here the nearby schools will also be invited.
 - e. Panel Discussion – Parents session- This year an initiative was taken by the school to have a panel discussion on -positive mind, positive vibes, positive life for students of grade 9th. The panel included the head girl, student of grade 11 & 10th, two parents, alumni, counsellor, coordinator – grade 9th and Principal. It was a success as lot of open discussion happened. In future planning to have a panel discussion for grade 7th & 8th.
 - f. SFA – The school had actively participated in the SFA events. The registration for the same happened in the school premises on Saturday 10th August 2024.
