1) Welcome

2) Introduction of New Principal

Chairperson, Ms Maya Sawant, mentioned about her retirement in the month of June i.e.on 30th June 2024. She welcomed the new Principal of City Pride School, Nigdi branch, Dr. Mrs Kanchan Deshpande and introduced her to all the members. Further, she mentioned that Dr.Mrs Kanchan Deshpande would take the charge with effect from Mon 01st July 2024.

- The students of City Pride School have secured outstanding 100% results in the Std X & XII CBSE Board Exams 2023-24.
- The students of grade V and grade VIII have made us proud with their overwhelming performance in the Ganit Prabhutva Exam (Mathex) 2023-24.
- The school has received excellent results at the Homibhabha Balvaigyanik Spardha 2023-24. From Std 6 - Anulekha N bagged Silver medal and a cash prize, Swara G. bagged Silver medal and a cash prize, Shravi K bagged Bronze medal and a cash prize, and from Std -9 Vasundhara M bagged Silver medal and a cash prize. - Under Sports Area, various team and individual achievements at various events like Yoga, Basketball, Volleyball, Throwball, Swimming, Archery were shared with the members. Adding on to this, Chairperson, Ms Maya Sawant also mentioned about the SFA championship held at Balewadi wherein City Pride School secured second position & won Rs.50,000/- first place in Athletics. 5) Selection of Office Bearers 2023-2024

The names of Office Bearers were read out by Chairperson, Mrs Maya Sawant. All the other members of E-PTA agreed, accepted and confirmed the office bearers.

She further explained the rules and responsibilities of the members and office bearers, and mentioned that the E-PTA meetings will be conducted once in every three months. Everyone will be intimated fifteen days prior about the next meeting. Important school related issues and concerns will be taken up in the meeting. Members are free to give their valuable feedback on the processes followed at school.

6) Discussion and sharing of thoughts

All members shared their views about the school and shared their experience with the School, following points were discussed.

- Mrs. Alok Shah appreciated the change in the school ground floor. He shared that the students love coming for the evening sports due to this change now. He also appreciated the event "Business City" conducted in the month of April wherein he thanked school for providing such an experiential learning platform to the students.
- Mrs. Kalia appreciated the school saying that the school always organises new innovative events. She shared her experience about the picnic which she had accompanied the students and teachers and mentioned that it was very well organised picnic. She expressed proud feelings to be the part of City Pride School family.
- Mrs. Alok Shah suggested that queries of particular parent or class should not be raised directly on the whatsapp group. It should first go the coordinators to resolve it. Mrs. Maya Sawant mentioned that queries can be informed to the coordinators and the class teachers. She also said that parents should avoid calling teachers after 5 pm for any personal work to respect the personal time of teachers. They can send a message on the WhatsApp group. Only, in case of any emergency they can call the teachers or any higher authorities.
- Mrs. Ashwini Hirwe suggested to introduce breakfast coupon system for Std 11th and 12th as it becomes difficult for the students to carry the cash every day. Mrs. Maya Sawant said that the school will think and let them know about the same.

7) Any other point with the permission of the chairperson

- Chairperson, Mrs. Maya Sawant mentioned, the change in the school timings for std 3 and std 4. So, as per the new rule by the State Govt the school starting timing is - 9.15am. All the members shared their views saying that they prefer starting time 8.15 am for std 4 because then the children reach home early by 3.30 pm and get sufficient time to carry out other activities comfortably. Chairperson, Mrs Maya Sawant mentioned that to accommodate the scholastic and co-scholastic activities done at school we need sufficient time, hence we will have to run the school till 4.30 pm. Members shared that it is too late and tiring for the children to reach home after 4.30pm. The members requested the school to start Std 4th at 8.15am and end at 3.30 pm. Chairperson, Mrs Maya Sawant said the school will take a consent regarding the timings of std 4 from the parents by sending a Google form.

8) Vote of Thanks

The Chairperson Mrs. Maya Sawant, thanked everyone for their presence and mentioned that the next meeting will take place after three months. The date of the meeting will be informed well in advance.
